LUC President Jack Reser called the meeting to order at 1:15 PM.

**Members absent:** Tracy Allen, Paul Blair, Scott Coleman, Jim Coon, Rob Cummins, Bill Edwards, Jack Engle, Barry Moffett, Fereidoun Shokouhi, Jim Thompson, and City of Marysville Engineer Designee.

**Guests present:** Judy Christian of York Township, Wes Dodds and Heather Martin of LUC Regional Planning.

**Minutes:** Max Coates made the first motion to approve the Minutes of the July 10, 2008 Executive Committee Meeting. Charles Hall made the second motion. All in favor.

**Treasurer's Report:** LUC Treasurer Andy Yoder presented the Financial Report. Charles Hall questioned the budget as showing supplies as running short. Jenny reported the reason for this was due to the numerous amounts of equipment that needed replaced, the purchase of new equipment for the hiring of Kyle, and then the computer for Heather. All equipment comes from the supplies line item. Mike Bow made the first motion to accept the Financial Report. Steve Stolte seconded the motion. All in favor.

**ODOT Reports:** Rob Cummins submitted report for ODOT District 7 and Tracy Allen for ODOT District 6, both as attached. Charles updated everyone that as of Monday, Route 4 is now open.

**New Business:**

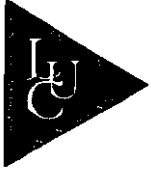
1. Jack Reser acknowledged Steve Stolte who had been honored by NACo (National Association of Counties) as the 2008 award winner in the rural category for a deserving county official. Steve is the first Ohio recipient. Steve was nominated because of his longstanding commitment and dedication to making Union County a safer and better place to live for people of all ages. Appreciation is given to Steve for representing the region and this committee well. Steve gave a small thank you speech thanking others for their support.
2. Review of a Zoning Amendment to the Marion Brooks Parcel# K41-11-11-10-00-019-05, 1955 S. Dugan Road, in Urbana Township (Champaign County) from U-1 Rural District to B-1 Service Business. Mr. Brooks currently operates a Retail Tire Store as a conditional use on the property.



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He wishes to expand his business to include Automobile Repair and Storage Facilities. Charles Hall made the first motion to accept the staff and Zoning and Subdivision Committee's recommendation for denial and further recommend that the owner apply for a Conditional Use Permit. Steve Stolte seconded the motion. All in favor.

3. Review of Zoning Amendments to the Jerome Township (Union County) Zoning Resolution regarding Section 549 "Objectionable Uses". Steve Stolte made the first motion to accept staff and Zoning and Subdivision Committee's recommendation for approval of the Zoning Amendment on Section 549 Objectionable Uses written as: "In the M-1 and M-2 Districts the following uses are **shall not be permitted**", and with the consideration to expand to the B – Business Districts as well. Max Coates seconded the motion. All in favor.
4. Review of Zoning Amendments to the Jerome Township (Union County) Zoning Resolution regarding Section 557 "Parking and Storage of Certain Vehicles". Charles Hall made the first motion to accept staff and Zoning and Subdivision Committee's recommendation for denial. Rick Shortell seconded the motion. All in favor.
5. Review of Zoning Amendments to the Jerome Township (Union County) Zoning Resolution regarding Article VI-A Planned Unit Developments. At the Zoning and Subdivision Meeting this was not a unanimous vote to pass. There was one "Nay" vote due to the rules not being firm enough, and there are no minimum standards. Steve noted that he supported this action at the meeting, but he understands there are some issues with it. There have been questions about the legality of PUD regulation that are currently in place. Further, Steve felt it was important to get something in place even if it's not ideal. Max Coates made the first motion to accept staff and Zoning and Subdivision Committee's recommendation for approval with the numerous considerations for change outlined in the Staff Report. Bill Kelley seconded the motion. Vote: 16 in favor and 1 not in favor.
6. Review of the Darby Braeside Preliminary Plat in Jerome & Darby Townships, Union County. Charles Hall made the first motion to accept staff and Zoning and Subdivision Committee's recommendation to **approve** the plat subject to comments from the reviewing agencies including LUC Regional Planning Commission in the Staff Report which must be incorporated into the Construction Drawings and Final Plat. Ryan Shoffstall seconded the motion. All in favor.
7. Review of the Autumn Ridge Amended Preliminary Plat in Darby Township, Union County. Jenny received a call from the Darby Township Trustees who would like us to recommend that drainage issues continue to be worked on in the subdivision. For example, drainage tile needs to be repaired that was broken during the construction of the cul-de-sac abutting lot 19 has caused drainage issues on adjoining properties. Soil & Water District and the Trustees had advised the developer in April and it has yet to be fixed. Jenny has a call in to Soil & Water to discuss. Steve Stolte made the first motion to accept staff and Zoning and Subdivision Committee's recommendation for to **approve** the plat subject to comments from the reviewing agencies including the Darby Township Trustees and LUC Regional Planning Commission in the Staff



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Report which must be incorporated into the Construction Drawings and Final Plat. Mike Bow seconded the motion. All in favor with Bill Kelley abstaining from the vote.

8. The Executive Committee Officer's met to discuss the results of the Strategic Planning Session. Jack was very pleased with the planning session and felt that Jenny did a great job of pulling the information together. As a result of both meetings, an amended mission statement has been suggested. If everyone could review and have suggestions, questions, or be ready to act on it at the next meeting. In addition, the Building Committee met on Tuesday afternoon to discuss the facilities. There are appointments scheduled with basement repair companies to get quotes, and the committee is looking at the layout of the LUC Board Room. Jenny will send the entire Strategic Planning Report to the Executive Committee. Jack noted that in the minutes from the Officer's Meeting that there was an error in item # f. It should instead read: Maybe instead of an increase to members, we need to look at cutting expenses.

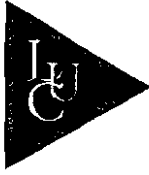

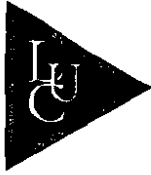
