Small City Applications

Staff coordinated with the City of Urbana staff on safety studies on S. Main Street and West Miami Street. These studies were also part of the general planning services task order in Work Element 601.2/601.21. Both studies made short term recommendations that could be incorporated in the upcoming Urban Paving projects as well as long term improvements that could be pursued with other funding sources.

Staff coordinated and participated in Technical Advisory Committee meetings to prioritize and review planning activities. The committee met four times during this period. Staff prepared various exhibits for submittal to ODOT and the LUC Executive Committee reflecting these priorities.

This work element tracks expenditures for a general services consultant contract and its associated task orders. A summary of each task order follows.

CHP Urbana South Main Street Study

The CHP Urbana South Main Street Study analyzed South Main Street (US 68) from the PreK-8 School North to Reynolds Street ahead of an ODOT resurfacing project in 2022. The study analyzed crash data through the corridor and recommended both short term and long term fixes to improve safety through the corridor. The short term recommendations could be implemented during the paving project (i.e re-striping pavement markings), while the long term recommendations would need ODOT Safety, or other funding sources to accomplish them.

CHP St. Paris Trail Feasibility Study

The CHP St. Paris Trail Feasibility Study was done to investigate a potential east/west trail through Champaign County. The feasibility study looked at the trail in 4 separate segments. The segments were from west to east the Champaign/Miami County line to St. Paris, within the village of St. Paris, St. Paris to SR.560, and SR.560 to the City of Urbana. The focal point of the study was the section of trail within the Village of St. Paris, as their stakeholders were the primary driver of the study and that section of trail is likely the most feasible to construct. The recommendations include staying primarily within the former rail right of way, but would also involve the purchase of private right of way and utilization of public road right of way.

CHP Urbana Miami Street Safety Study

The CHP Urbana Miami Street Street Safety Study was done ahead of a paving job by ODOT. The study boundaries were along US 36 (Miami Street) from Walnut Street to Edgewood Ave. The purpose of the study was to analyze crash data and identify negative trends that could be mitigated with minor improvements during the paving job. Minor, short term improvements would include changes in

pavement markings that could be implemented during the paving project. Longer term recommendations were also recommended, but would need to be done through a different project and funding source (ODOT Safety).

CHP Gwynne Street Bridge Study

The Gwynne Street Bridge Study was scoped during FY22, but will be delivered in FY23. The study will identify potential improvements that will help sustain the bridge for years to come. The identified improvements will also come with cost estimates to help with future planning.
