Capital Program Update

The applications for RTPO capital program funds were sent out to potential applicants in mid October. Funding amounts over the next four fiscal years can be found in the table below. Applications are due on December 10th. The two week public involvement period will be held in January, 2026. The LUC TAC will review the applications and recommend funding at its January 26th TAC meeting. That recommendation will be brought before the LUC Executive Committee in either February or March, 2026.

City of Bellefontaine Signage Inventory Study Update

Data collection for the signage inventory study in Bellefontaine is nearly complete. Once complete, the consultant will conduct quality control before finalizing the report. The study is expected to be completed by the end of the year or in early 2026.

Trail Count Program

LUC/TCC/City of Urbana and the Simon Kenton Pathfinders met in November to discuss trail counting efforts in Logan and Champaign County. Over the coming months counters that have been vandalized/stopped working in Urbana will be replaced. Additional counters will also be placed in North Lewisburg and Indian Lake to support bike/ped counts in those locations. Finally, Eco Counters will be strategically placed along the Simon Kenton Trail at high volume locations over the coming years as these counters are more reliable and easier to manage.

LUC President Tim Cassady called the meeting to order at 7:28 pm.

New Business:

1. Tim Cassady presented the Nominating Committee Report for the 2026 Executive Committee Members to the LUC membership.
 - a. Steve McCall moved a motion to accept the Nominating Committee's 2026 Executive Committee Members Report and Steve Robinson seconded. All in favor.
2. Todd Freyhof presented the recommendations of the Budget and Finance Committee and Executive Committee to increase membership dues 15 cents per capita for counties, townships and villages; an increase of 20 cents per capita for cities; an increase of \$500 to the city minimum fee; and establishment of an additional \$2,500 assessment to townships with a population over 5,000.
 - a. Mike Yoder moved a motion to accept the Executive Committee's recommendation to increase membership dues as recommended by the Budget & Finance Committee, and Greg Iiams seconded. All in favor.
- A. Brad Bodenmiller provided information on the work performed by LUC Staff and the organization. He thanked everyone in the room, the Executive Committee members, LUC employees and local jurisdictions for their support, and he thanked Tim for his work and support of LUC.
- B. Tim Cassady expressed his appreciation for the unique vantage point that comes with being the smallest county in the LUC. He noted that this position allows them to learn from others' examples and benefit from a wide range of perspectives, ideas, and readily available information. Tim added that he appreciates the LUC's guidance, noting that they consistently do excellent work on behalf of all three member counties.

Steve McCall moved a motion to adjourn the LUC Annual Meeting at approximately 7:47 pm, and Todd Freyhof seconded. All in favor.

The Health Department is working with the Prosecutor's Office to draft an agreement to require connection of the property at 8240 Mitchell Dewitt Road to the sanitary sewer system that is brought in for the development upon failure of the current sewage treatment system at 8240 Mitchell Dewitt Road.
- Todd Freyhof moved a motion to accept the recommendation of conditional approval of the Lark Ravine Preliminary Plat incorporating all the Health Department comments, and Mike Yoder seconded. All in favor.
2. Review of The Courtyards at White Oaks Phase 2 Final Plat (Union County) – Staff Report by Brad Bodenmiller
- Brad Bodenmiller – I noticed on the revised Plat, there is a 5' Utility Easement (U.E.) along the north line of Lot 2710. This is too narrow and, in speaking with the subdivider's engineer, he will be change this to a 5' Drainage Easement (D.E.) on the Plat by hand-marking the label.
 - Scott Coleman moved a motion to accept the recommendation of conditional approval of The Courtyards at White Oaks Phase 2 Final Plat with a change to the easement on the north line of Lot 2710 to change the 5' easement from Utility Easement to a drainage easement, and Steve McCall seconded.
