The following are items for discussion at the July 10, 2025 LUC Executive Committee Meeting.

LUC Functional Classification Update

Functional Classification reviews take place once every ten years following the decennial census. This most recent functional classification review started mid-year 2024 and will conclude by the end of August 2025. Local governments within Logan and Champaign County reviewed the existing functional class network and sent recommended changed to ODOT for review. ODOT and FHWA reviewed the recommended changes and responded with questions and or comments. All concerns have been addressed and FHWA has found all justifications, revisions, and supporting documentation to be acceptable and they concur with the approval of the revisions to Ohio's Highway Functional Classification System. The list of functional classification changes are included in the resolution before the Executive Committee for approval.

A RESOLUTION

OF THE LOGAN-UNION-CHAMPAIGN-REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION ADOPTING THE UPDATES TO THE HIGHWAY FUNCTIONAL CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM FOR LOGAN AND CHAMPAIGN COUNTIES

WHEREAS, the Logan-Union-Champaign Regional Planning Commission (LUC) is designated as the Regional Transportation Planning Organization (RTPO) for Logan and Champaign Counties by the Governor of the State of Ohio, acting through the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT), and in cooperation with locally elected officials in the area pursuant to an Agreement between ODOT and LUC; and

WHEREAS, the public roadways within the Logan and Champaign coverage areas are classified cooperatively by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), ODOT and LUC as arterials, collectors and local roads according to their intended purpose for moving through traffic, providing land access or a combination of both; and

WHEREAS, ODOT and LUC cooperatively reviewed and submitted proposed revisions to the Logan and Champaign region Highway Functional Classification System following the 2020 decennial census; and

WHEREAS, FHWA approved the current Highway Functional Classification System in the Logan and Champaign region as part of the State of Ohio approval on June 20, 2025; and

WHEREAS, revisions to the Highway Functional Classification System in the LUC Region require concurrence of the LUC, ODOT and FHWA before becoming effective.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED:

That the members of the Logan-Union-Champaign Regional Planning Commission approve and concur with the current Highway Functional Classification System approved for LUC by FHWA on June 20, 2025.

Comments from Individuals: Ben Vollrath reported that Logan County Commissioners approved a 3% lodging tax on short-term rentals and he commends the commissioners for their leadership in this process. He states that 15 years ago, they had less than 10; now they have over 300, which is a significant income from tourism. He encourages other communities to do the same. Brad Bodenmiller asked Vollrath to explain how the tax is split, and he did. Beau Michael questioned what the definition of a short-term rental was, how it is tracked, and if they have received proceeds yet. Ben Vollrath defined short-term rentals as "any transient guest for less than 30 days" (campgrounds excluded). Mike Yoder added that this has recently passed and will not go into effect until January 1, 2026.
