New Business:

- 1. Welcome and Introductions were completed.
- 2. December 5, 2022, Meeting Minutes
 - a. Scott Schmid moved a motion to accept the minutes as written and Scott Coleman seconded. All in favor.
- 3. RTPO Capital Program Updates
 - a. Louis Agresta provided an update.
 - b. Louis Agresta asked if the funds needed moved to the fourth quarter for the Urbana-Woodstock Pike reconstruction project. Scott Schmid advised that if it's been advertised, that's not needed. Mark Mowery advised that it has been advertised. Later in the meeting, Mark advised that it has been contracted.
 - c. Simon Kenton Trail E. Lawn Extension Feasibility Study
 - Louis Agresta asked if the funds should be moved to quarter four.
 Tyler Bumbalough reported it's under preliminary design. Scott Schmid advised to push it back to the quarter four.
