The following are items for discussion and action at the December 9 LUC Executive Committee Meeting

### FY21-24 RTIP Amendment #2

As a reminder, as part of the most recent state transportation budget, money was allocated to RTPOs to conduct a rural transportation planning grant program. ODOT notified LUC that it will receive a portion of those monies through a modest STBG allocation. Applications for Federal Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) funding were due August 30.

TCC Staff presented funding recommendations to the RTPO TAC at their November 1 meeting. The TAC reviewed the staff prepared information and approved the following funding recommendations:

- LOG-CR18 Profile Improvements: Fund full request of \$151,713 for CO/CE with the understanding the requested amount will be reduced between today's TAC meeting and the Executive Committee decision. Any savings from the reduced amount will go to funding the CHP-Upper Valley Pike Widening request.
- LOG-TR179 Widening (TR181-CR10): Fund full request of \$98,291 for CO/CE.
- CHP-Urbana Bike Trail Crossing Safety Improvements.: Fund partial request in the amount of \$44,900 for activity of PE and DD.
- CHP-Urbana Woodstock Pike Reconstruction Design: Fund partial request in the amount of \$48,000 for activity of PE environmental and PE DD.
- CHP-Upper Valley Pike Widening: Fund partial request in the amount of \$49,096 for CO. Additionally, any savings from the reduced amount of LOG-CR18 Profile Improvements will go to funding this partial request for CO.

These recommendations, including a reduction in funding for LOG-CR18 Profile Improvements and an increase in funding for CHP-Upper Valley Pike Widening, have been programmed by ODOT District 7 and are attached to the RTIP amendment Resolution in this agenda packet.

TCC Staff requests discussion and approval of the RTIP amendment as attached at the December 9 meeting.

### CHP/St. Paris Trail Study

The CHP/St. Paris Trail Feasibility Study was officially kicked off at a meeting on October 20 with the task order consultant team, Village officials, and local stakeholders. The consultant team captured feedback from that meeting to begin preparing alternative alignments for an east/west trail from Miami County to Urbana.

The consultant team mapped the abandoned rail corridor and various roadway crossings using an aerial drone on December 3. The information collected will be used to compare and to estimate the costs of various alignments. The next stakeholder meeting is tentatively set for late January 2022 with a task completion date of February 28, 2022.

#### A RESOLUTION

OF THE LOGAN-UNION-CHAMPAIGN-REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION TO APPROVE AMENDMENT #2 FOR THE SFY 2021 – SFY 2024 REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR LOGAN AND CHAMPAIGN COUNTIES

WHEREAS, the Logan-Union-Champaign Regional Planning Commission (LUC) is designated as the Regional Transportation Planning Organization (RTPO) for Logan and Champaign Counties by the Governor of the State of Ohio, acting through the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT), and in cooperation with locally elected officials in the area pursuant to an Agreement between ODOT and LUC; and

WHEREAS, LUC is responsible for maintaining the Regional Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for Logan and Champaign Counties, in cooperation with local governments, transportation providers, and the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT); and

WHEREAS, LUC and ODOT have made modifications to the programming documents for various projects, which are identified on the attached lists, resulting in the need for a SFY2021-SFY2024 TIP amendment; and

WHEREAS, the amendment is consistent with the LUC Regional Transportation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the amendment will result in a TIP that is in reasonable fiscal constraint; and

**WHEREAS**, the next scheduled update of the biennial Transportation Improvement Program is not until SFY2023.

#### BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED:

That the members of the LUC Executive Committee approve the amendment to the SFY 2021-SFY 2024 Regional Transportation Improvement Program as shown on the attachment.
