L/C Rural Consultation Meeting

The STIP (Statewide Transportation Improvement Program) rural consultation process provides an opportunity for ODOT and rural local officials to discuss their current transportation plans and needs for the STIP development period. The meeting also provides an opportunity for ODOT staff to review the planned Federal investments in the community during the STIP period with rural local officials. The L/C rural consultation meeting will be held Wednesday, October 19th, 2022 at 1:00 pm. The meeting will be held in the Village of West Liberty upstairs meeting area. Simon Kenton Trail East Lawn Extension Feasibility Study
