



The following are items for discussion at the October 11 LUC Executive Committee Meeting

Urbana South High Street Corridor Study

Burgess and Niple were authorized to proceed on the South High Street Corridor Study on October 4 with an estimated study completion date of December 31. The study will be focused on drainage, parking, bicycle and pedestrian, and intersection safety improvements. There will be a public meeting held once initial evaluation of the corridor and preliminary findings and recommendations have been developed.

Highway Safety Field Reviews

TCC staff are currently reviewing crash data and the LUC 2018 Local Roadway Safety Program to compile a draft candidate list for safety field reviews. Staff will be contacting local officials to finalize a location list and schedule field reviews. The safety teams will consist of local planning, engineering, police and EMS personnel who are interested in attending.

Members absent: John Brose, Tim Cassady, Scott Coleman, Barry Moffett, Tim Notestine, Ryan Shoffstall, and George Showalter.

Guests present: Chris Harr, Reliant Mechanical; Fred Vogel, ODOT District 7 & 10 Regional Manager; Judy Christian, York Township; Kaye Borchers, Choice One Engineering; Brad Bodenmiller and Heather Martin of LUC Regional Planning Commission.

Minutes – John Bayliss moved a motion to approve the minutes from the September 13, 2018, meeting as written and Steve McCall seconded. All in favor.

Financial Report – Andy Yoder presented the Financial Report for September. Charles Hall moved a motion to accept the Financial Report and Wes Dodds seconded. All in favor.

ODOT Reports:

Brian Davidson reported for District 6; they have finished culverts for the year. They are now doing crack sealing and preparing for snow and ice. Scott Boyer reported for District 7. His reports have been updated and all are on the LUC web-site.

RTPO:

Dave Gulden reported for Scott Schmid. The TCC report is available on LUC's web-site. Steve McCall reported TCC is working on a safety plan for Champaign County. Champaign County appreciates TCC's assistance with that plan and their continued work.

New Business:

1. Review of Mills of Watkins Preliminary Plat (Union County) – Staff Report by Brad Bodenmiller



- Steve McCall moved a motion to accept the recommendation of approval with conditions for the Mills of Watkins Preliminary Plat including all comments and Dave Faulkner seconded. All in favor.
- 2. Budget Committee Andy Yoder
 - Andy Yoder moved a motion to make employee raises effective the first pay period of 2019 and John Bayliss second. All in favor.
- 3. Building Committee Dave Gulden
 - Dave Gulden provided an update. He met with the Logan County Prosecutor in September. The Prosecutor sent a letter to the previous bidder with a deadline of October 12 to complete the sale. If not completed, the bid could be released. Dave reported that recently there is some additional interest in the building from Reliant Mechanical.
 - Chris Harr Reliant Mechanical has a division that we split off about a year to be a freestanding, standalone company; it's in start up mode. We have a large contract with Honda of America and we have aspirations to grow that to something larger than it is now. They need a home. We're bursting at the seams to house them. Currently some are on Honda property, but we would like to have them all located together. I've found some other properties. I'd like them close to East Liberty and close to Reliant, but it needs to function separately. I have high interest in the LUC building. I don't know the aspirations of the people who bid on it, or what they plan to do with it. I plan to put a business in it, a business that's growing and will be an asset to East Liberty, Logan County and Union County. I can write you a check if you want one right now. I'm on a tight time table. I'm been in an exhaustive search over the last two months for a property. I have three potential properties, and this is the one I prefer.

 - Charles Hall Maybe a lease with the option to buy; then again, that's still a Prosecutor's decision.
 - Due to potential conflict of interest, John Bayliss excused himself from the room and discussion.
 - Andy Yoder Should we be having this discussion in executive session?
 - Dave Gulden It's not our property, it's Logan County's so I don't think we have to, but if you want to we can.
